

Rites Postponed Until Wednesday

SERVICES for Joseph John Maketzky, 59, of 307 N. 3rd St., have been postponed until 9 a.m. Wednesday at St. Mary's Catholic Church, because of relatives coming from a distance.

The service originally was set for Tuesday morning. Rosary will be said at 8:15 p.m. Tuesday at Kreuger Mortuary, instead of Monday evening. Military services are planned at St. Mary's Catholic Cemetery.

Mr. Maketzky was born March 19, 1895 at Lida, Poland. He was a resident of Aberdeen since 1913 when he came from Poland. On Sept. 2, 1926 he married Emma Tieiz at Aberdeen.

He is survived by his widow, a son, John, of St. Paul, Minn., a daughter, Mrs. Gerald (Irene) Davies of Minneapolis, Minn., and two grandchildren.

Mr. Maketzky had been employed by the Milwaukee Road for 41 years before retiring a year ago because of illness. He was a bridgebuilder and carpenter for the railroad and was a member of the Brotherhood of Maintenance of way. He was a world war I veteran.
