

SMOLESKI, GAS VICTIM IN WAR, DIES AT BEACON

Justin Smoleski, of 67 West Seventeenth street, this city, who was gassed in the World War and who has been under treatment for the past year at the Castle Point Hospital, Beacon, N. Y., died Sunday at that institution.

Mr. Smoleski was a private in Battery F of the 112th Field Artillery and served overseas for two years before he was discharged in 1919. He was a resident of this city for the past 22 years.

Mr. Smoleski is survived by his widow, Mrs. Helen Smoleski; one son, Matthew, and one daughter, Priscilla, and one sister, Mrs. Joseph M. Gurski. The funeral will take place Thursday morning with a solemn high requiem mass being celebrated at 9:30 at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Roman Catholic Church. Interment will be at the convenience of the family under the direction of Stanley Fryczynski.
