

Mrs. Mary Sladek Dies at Chippewa

CHIPPEWA FALLS.—Mrs. Mary Sladek, 74, died at her home at 6:45 following a lingering illness. She was born Mary Golinski, Nov. 22, 1870, in Russian Poland, and was married there to Frank Sladek. They came to America in 1907, and settled in Chippewa Falls, where they made their home ever since.

Mr. Sladek died in 1912. Surviving are four sons and one daughter, Thomas Sladek of Milwaukee; Wallace Sladek, of Rome, Ga.; Joseph Sladek, Chippewa Falls; Robert Sladek of Long Beach, Calif., and Mrs. Helen Moucka, Milwaukee. One daughter, Mrs. Josephine Manko preceded her in death in 1937. She was a member of Notre Dame church.

Funeral services will be held Saturday at 9 a. m. at Notre Dame church. The body will be at the La Frania Funeral home from this afternoon until time of the funeral. The rosary will be recited at 8 p. m. Friday at the funeral home.
