I was born in Salsalazar, Austria,
on the 7th day of June, anno Domini 1870; I now reside
at Glen Flora, Wis.

I emigrated to the United States of America from Bremen, Germany
on the vessel Elba; my last

foreign residence was Salsalazar, Austria.
